Join the German Immersion Foundation in welcoming the Amity Interns for the Spring semester.



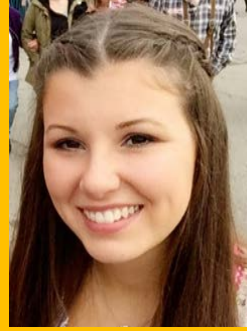
**Katharina Winter** has been assigned to the MGIS classrooms of Frau Heck in K4 and Frau Prah and Herr Piwek in grade 4.
