



The Patricia & H. Carl Mueller Scholarships *for German language study and application*

Two \$500 non-renewable scholarships available for the 2017-18 academic year through German Immersion Foundation, Inc.

To recognize the importance of continued study and application of the German language in life, and to honor the commitment to Milwaukee German Immersion School and German Immersion Foundation by both Patricia and H. Carl Mueller, we are pleased to offer these two non-renewable scholarships.

Selection Criteria

Applicants will be reviewed according to their academic qualifications (course selection and academic performance), extracurricular involvement, letters of recommendation and essays. Consideration will be given to those applicants who have continued their German language studies through high school and/or into college. The Selection Committee reserves the right to conduct personal interviews with scholarship candidates as necessary.

Scholarship Eligibility and Information

Applicants must:

- Be an alumnus or alumna of Milwaukee German Immersion School, having completed the fifth grade;
- Be a high school senior or graduate planning to enroll full time, or a student already enrolled full time (as defined by the institution), in an undergraduate course of study at an accredited postsecondary institution;
- Be accepted to an accredited post-secondary institution;
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale).

Students may apply for only one of these scholarships. An individual who has already earned a bachelor's degree is not eligible for consideration.

Application procedure

Interested students must complete the scholarship application form (see reverse) and mail it along with the following required documents:

- Completed essay in English (writing prompt below);
- Current, complete transcript of grades (unofficial are acceptable); and
- At least one letter of recommendation.

Deadline/Timeline

Complete application packets must be postmarked on or before May 1, 2017. Selection will be completed by May 31, 2017. Winners will be notified by mail and will be invited to the 2018 German Immersion Foundation annual dinner and silent auction at which they will be recognized.
